

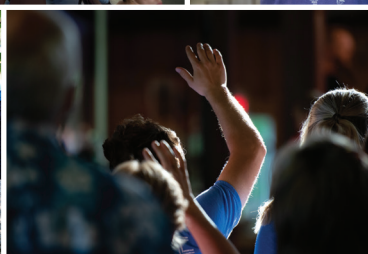

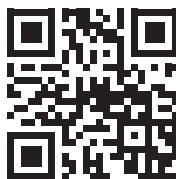

Purchase prepaid meal cards at the dining hall. This year we are accepting cash, credit card, and debit.

The NEW self serve Breakfast Bar consists of a daily selection of foods including toast, bagels, muffins/doughnuts/danishes, oatmeal, cold cereals, yogurt, fruit, and two alternating hot items such as omelettes, boiled eggs, scrambled eggs, pancakes, french toast, waffles, etc. Hot and cold beverages are included.
