## The Ridge Church Worship Team




The Ridge Church Worship Team has been faithfully leading worship together for more than a decade. What began as a group of musicians has grown into

## Pet Policy

Animals are not permitted in any Camp & Conference Center building, or on the beach (Department of Health directive). When dogs are not confined within a cottage or trailer, leashes are always required and owners are expected to clean up after their pets.

Advance approval is required when more than two dogs are housed on one lot at any time. At the discretion of BCCC Leadership, dogs may be required to wear a bark collar. Dog owners may be required to remove their dogs from the grounds upon written notice should safety concerns or excessive noise persist.
